DOCTRINAL POSITION OF EVANGEL CHURCH (please read and sign if in accord):

There is one God, who is infinitely perfect and holy, existing eternally in three persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, Creator of heaven and earth.

Jesus Christ is true God and true man. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He died upon the cross, the Just for the unjust, as God's substitutionary sacrifice for sin; all who believe in Him alone are justified on the ground of His shed blood as a propitiation for sin. He arose from the dead and is seated on the right hand of God as our great High Priest.

The Holy Spirit is the divine third person of the Trinity, sent to regenerate sinners unto repentance and faith, to indwell, guide, teach and empower the believer, and to convince the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment.

The Old and New Testaments, inerrant as originally given, were verbally inspired by God and are a complete revelation of His will for the salvation of men. They constitute the divine and only rule of Christian faith and practice.

Man was originally created in the image and likeness of God; he fell through disobedience, incurring both physical and spiritual death. All men are born with a sinful nature, are separated from the life of God, and can be saved only through the atoning work of the Lord Jesus Christ. Salvation has been provided through Jesus Christ for all men; those who repent and believe in Him are born again of the Holy Spirit, receive the gift of eternal life, and become children of God by adoption.

The Church consists of all those who believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, who is the Head and King of the body, the Church, which has been commissioned by Him to go into all the world as a witness, preaching the gospel to all generations.

The local church is a body of believers in Jesus Christ who are joined together for the worship of God, for edification through the teaching and preaching of the Word, for prayer, fellowship, proclamation of the gospel, and observances of the ordinances of baptism and communion. The Second Coming of the Lord Jesus is immanent and will be personal and visible. There shall be a bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust; for the former, a resurrection unto eternal life; for the latter, a resurrection unto judgment. This is the believer's blessed and sure hope, and is a vital truth which is an incentive to holy living and faithful service.
