1. Based on this passage from Mark 1, what are some of the ways Christ ministered to others? How do you see His miracles as being part of His ministry? What does Christ say is His priority in verse 38?
2. Christ truly redeemed the time given to Him on earth. How do you see Him effectively using His time in this passage? Read the following passages and consider the perfectly purposeful life of Christ: Luke 4:16-30 and Matthew 16:21-23.
3. When Christ healed Peter's mother in law, how do you think this might have changed Peter's family's perception of Christ? Pick three of the miracles of Christ in the Gospels and reflect on how they radically effected the recipient's life.
4. When Jesus worked a miracle it was not for the purpose of entertainment. What are some of the purposes of miracles spoken of in this study? How do these purposes differ from those of modern "miracle workers"?
5. How do Christ's miracles confirm His teaching? Read Matthew 2:1-12. Which is easier for Christ to say, "get up and walk" or "your sins are forgiven"? Why? How do Christ's miracles explained by His teaching call us to faith in Him?
6. Ultimately, Christ's miracles reflect the nature of eternal life. Close your study by turning Revelation 21:1-8 into a prayer of praise and thanksgiving.
