

## **Health Guidelines for all Evangel Sunday School Classes and Children's Ministry Activities**

In an effort to maintain high health standards in all of our Sunday school and Children's Ministry classes, beginning October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020 we ask that those who attend classes, including children and adults, read, agree with, and commit to following these guidelines:

### **Children's Sunday school Guidelines**

Guidelines for Evangel Children's Sunday school classes and Children's Ministry for fall of 2020 (note: these guidelines are subject to change):

- All teachers and students will be expected to practice social distancing. The chairs and desks in all of the rooms will be placed accordingly.
- Teachers are expected to be on time and have hand sanitizer, masks, and any other supplies needed to provide a sanitized environment (supplies provided by the church).
- Teachers and children should wear a mask or shield while walking to and from class in the hallways. In class, the teachers are required to wear a mask or shield while teaching unless the children are at least 6' away, in which case they do not have to wear a mask or shield. Children will wear a mask while in class unless 6' social distancing can be maintained.
- The teacher should instruct and reinforce proper hand hygiene and respiratory protocol (covering coughs and sneezes, etc.).
- After class, the teachers need to wipe down frequently touched surfaces like desks, door knobs, sink handles, etc. with provided cleaning supplies.
- If a child needs to be excused to go to the restroom, a mask must be worn.
- Parents with children 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and under should pick up their children at the end of Sunday school class. Parents need to wear a mask in the hallways.

### **Adult Sunday School Guidelines**

Guidelines for Evangel Adult Sunday school classes fall of 2020 (note: these guidelines are subject to change):

- All teachers and attendees are expected to practice social distancing. The chairs in all of the rooms will be placed accordingly.
- Teachers will be supplied with hand sanitizer, masks, and any other supplies needed to provide a sanitized environment.
- Teachers should wear a mask or shield while teaching unless attendees are more than 6' away. If attendees are, the teacher does not need to wear a mask or shield.
- Attendees are expected to wear a mask. If there are few attendees in a class and they can sit 6' apart, a mask is not required to be worn.
